- **Registration:**
 - Pre-registration is appreciated.
 - Mandatory drivers briefing begins Sunday at noon.
- **Event Time:** Races start at 12:30 pm
- **Entry Fee:** \$20 per driver and includes one additional pit pass.
 - Extra pit passes are \$10 at the gate.
- **Payout:** (in each class)
 - 1st—\$300
 - 2nd—\$200
 - 3rd—\$100 (Must have a minimum of six cars to win 3rd prize)
- **Classes:** (cars can move up one class if desired)
 - 4 cylinder
 - 6 cylinder
 - 8 cylinder
 - Heats and finals to be determined by the number of entrants in each class.
- **Other:** Must be 16 or older (with parent's permission) to participate.

Rules & Regulations

1. Standard passenger cars and station wagons will be allowed. No 4-wheel drives, trucks, or convertibles.
2. Cars will maintain standard height (maximum 20" bumper height)
3. All glass must be removed from the vehicle before entering the grounds. (Including headlights and taillights) No dismantling on premises.
4. All hoods and trunks must be able to be opened for inspection.
 - a. Hood must be secured with 4 bolts or chains.
 - b. Hood must include a 1 sq. ft. hole for fire hose access.
 - c. Trunks must be secured with bolts or chains.
 - d. The trunk must be empty.
5. No reinforcements of frame or body structure other than the following exceptions:
 - a. Driver's door: 2 horizontal bars allowed and cannot be attached to frame.
 - b. Driver's seat: 1 bar allowed behind the driver's seat.
 - c. 1 reinforcement bar running from bar behind driver to floor pan on passenger's side.
 - d. 1 bar may run across for steering wheel support only.
 - e. No roll cage.
6. Doors must be chained, strapped, or welded shut (up to 24" per door total weld)

7. Bumpers must be bolted on, bumper shocks may be bolted or welded.
8. Standard gas tanks must be removed from the car. The fuel tank must be inside the car, fastened securely, and covered up completely. Preferred installation in rear seat area.
9. Batteries must be installed inside the vehicle, preferably installed on the front passenger floor. Must be securely fastened and covered—no metal straps holding battery.
10. Engine and drive train must remain in original factory position. Motor may be welded, chained, or strapped on each side (2) behind pulleys.
11. Cars may run without radiators. Radiators must be in stock position. No cooling barrels.
12. All cars will have factory-equipped springs, 1 bolt on front A-frame, no solid rear suspension.
13. Tires not to exceed 1-6 ply tire wheel, air only. No snow or bar tires on drive wheels. All season radials are acceptable.
14. Cars must be equipped with seat belts and brakes.
 - a. Shoulder strap mandatory.
 - b. No rope allowed.
15. All drivers must wear an approved helmet (full faced, mouth guard, and protective clothing are recommended for your protection). If choosing to run without a full faced helmet, must install wire mesh on the driver's half of windshield. Eye protection is mandatory.
16. Numbers will be determined and put on at the race.
