## Rules & Regulations

1. A current copy of your horse's negative Coggins papers must be provided for each horse brought onto the Embarrass Region Fairgrounds.
2. Sign in with your name and your horse's name; print clearly. If we can't read it, we can't announce it.
3. Western attire is required for Halter and Pleasure classes. For other events, boots with a heel and a Western shirt are acceptable.
4. Be ready for the Performance Classes.
  - a. Your name will be called twice when it is your turn.
  - b. If you are not ready, you will be disqualified.
5. The time limit for high point events is 2 minutes, otherwise you will be disqualified.
6. Age group placements as of day of the show:
  - a. Pee Wee: 12 and under
  - b. Junior: 13 – 17 years of age
  - c. Senior: Age 18 and over
7. The Horse Show will take a break for the Parade at 3:45 pm.
8. Immediately following the parade, we will have the Future Riders Event. All Future Rider's horses must be led into the arena by a qualified individual. All riders will receive a ribbon as they exit the arena.
